Northern Ontario & C.A.F.E. National Youth Talent Program

Rules & Regulations

1. The contest is open to non-professional entertainers between the ages of 13 and 21. You must be a resident of Northwestern Ontario and at least 13 years and not have reached your 22nd birthday by June 11, 2011.
 2. The primary objective of the National Youth Talent Program is to encourage young Canadians to develop and advance their performing arts talents.
 3. For the purpose of this competition all participants must be of amateur status. Contestants may not be a member of a union connected with stage performances; may not earn more than 50% of their annual salary from performing; may not have sung or performed on a record, CD, or video released for commercial distribution through normal retail outlets; and may not have signed a management or booking contract with a professional firm or individual who is paid to secure continuous work as a performer.
 4. Baton twirlers or similar acts using machetes, knives, etc. are not eligible for competition. No fire or smoke or pyrotechnics effects will be allowed. The Youth Talent Search Committee at their discretion, reserve the right to disqualify any act deemed to be considered offensive, objectionable or dangerous.
 5. There are seven (7) categories of Acts for the National Youth Talent Program as follows: Vocal Solo, Instrument Solo, Dance Solo, Dance Group (up to 5), Vocal and/or Instrumental group (up to 5), Variety Solo and Variety group (up to 5).
 6. A contestant may enter in a maximum of two categories. A previous senior winner may not enter the contest. A Junior winner may enter again but is limited to a maximum of two wins. No mixing of Junior and Senior contestants in one group entry.
 7. **(Senior Competition Only) In any Vocal Category, instrumental accompanied by a person in the act or others is allowed, but must assume the pure character of accompaniment. The test shall be whether the performance would stand alone if the accompaniment were removed. Background CD'S for a vocalist cannot have any harmonies, voices, utterances, etc. of any kind.**
 8. In any Instrumental Category no instrument of the same nature may be used as accompaniment whether live or taped. (No accompaniment is allowed in a piano solo). If playing an organ or electric piano, no pre-programmed music is allowed. No instrument of the same nature as the performance may be used for the accompaniment. The test shall be whether the performance would stand alone if the accompaniment were removed.
 9. In any Dance Category accompanists are permitted on stage but must not assume visual importance in the performance. There must be no taps or tap effect on a CD used by the dancer.
 10. In a Variety Act (i.e.: musical theater, song and dance, instrumental, magician, juggler, etc.) all persons assuming visual importance in the act must meet age requirements.
- All contestants must have their own accompaniment either live or recorded. (Sr. Competition only): CD's cannot have any harmonies, voices, utterances if they are used in any Vocal Category. CD's returned after competition.
11. A contestant can participate in more than one regional/zone competition in the same year, but only once in the same regional/zone.
 12. **Acts running over four and one half (4.5) minutes will be disqualified. This rule will be strictly enforced.** We recommend that your act run approximately 3 - 4 minutes in length.
 13. **The order of performance is picked at random prior to the competition and will not be changed for any reason other than those changes necessitated by disqualifications.**
 14. No discussion shall be entered into by the contestants, or person(s) acting on their behalf, and the judges or the Youth Talent Committee Members regarding contest decisions. Failure to comply may result in disqualification of the Competitor from this and future competitions. Matters not covered by the stated rules are at the sole discretion of the Youth Talent Committee.
